Women make up only 6% of private pilots in Canada and fewer than 5% of all Airline Transport Pilot License holders are female. Female mechanics represent less than 2% of mechanics worldwide and women hold only 16% of jobs as Air Traffic Controllers in Canada.

### **Tour Information**




The Elevate Aviation Team
